JUST A SMALL AMOUNT OF FAITH

24.05.20 Session Aim

To know that with a tiny bit of faith there is the potential for great things. Also, that we never know what God might want to do with us and our faith, but we can trust in Him.

Bible Verse/s

Matthew 13:31-32, Mark 4:30-32, Luke 13:18-19, Luke 17:6

PRAYERFUL ACTIVITY – A TINY SEED

Equipment: A plant pot, soil, sunflower seeds (or any seed), pen and paper, glue or Sellotape to attach paper to the plant pot

Give the children a plant pot with soil in it and give them some sunflowers seeds to plant in the soil. On the side of the flower pot have the memory verse – If you have faith as small as a mustard seed you can say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it will obey you.' Luke 17:6.

Tell the children that as their sunflower grows it can remind them that the seed that they started with was small, but it is growing into something large. Remind them that this is the same as what their faith can be like.

The Point: To learn the bible verse and to remind them of the story each time they see their plant.

PRAYER

Pray: 'Lord, we thank you that even in difficult times we can have faith in you. We ask, God, that you can use our faith through this period to help us with any struggles we may have. We pray our faith in you grows over time like a mustard seed.

Reflect with the children on how God can help everyone through this period.

The Point: To help the children understand God is there with them no matter how much faith they have.
