"A man went out into his garden....," Jesus began. "A story!" said his friends. "We love Jesus' stories." Jesus went on, "The man had a tiny brown seed, the smallest of seeds- a mustard seed.

He knelt down and pressed his finger into the soil. He put the seed into the little hole. He covered the seed with soil. Then he watered the soil and went away.

"The seed began to grow. Soon a little green shoot appeared above the soil. The shoot grew up and up. Leaves unfolded and reached out to the sun. The shoot had become a small plant.

"The stem became the slim trunk of a tree. Branches formed and stretched out. Year after year, the tree's trunk thickened, and the branches lengthened. It grew and grew – until the plant that had grown from a tiny seed was the biggest tree in the whole garden!"



The Point: To explore the parable of the mustard seed and begin to understand that God can do big things with only a tiny amount of faith.
