To encourage young people to approach Jesus with faith, to recognise He is powerful and mighty to save.

Bible Verses to CHECK OUT!

Matthew 9:18-26, Mark 5:21-43, John 11:38-44, Hebrews 11

VIDEO/DISCUSSION:

WATCH: Jesus Raises the Daughter of Jairus

Equipment: Bible

Read Mark 5:21-43

We find two events linked together in this passage; each story helps us to understand the other.

One story, the story at the beginning and the end of this passage, is about one of the leaders of a local synagogue, Jairus, and his daughter. We don't know her name, but we're told she is 12 years old.

The story in the middle is about an older woman who has been bleeding for 12 years (the same amount of time – 12 years – linking the two stories together).

'Both stories are about fear and faith, and the power of Jesus to take people from one to the other' (Tom Wright).'

Use these questions to consider the passage and what it means for you:

Q1: Why do you think these stories are told together?

Q2: What do these stories teach us about faith?

Q3: What difference did faith make to Jairus and the woman who touched Jesus?

Q4: What do you think Mark, who wrote these stories, was wanting to tell us about Jesus?

The point: Exploring the passage from Mark 5:21-43; Jesus moves us from fear to faith.
