09.08.20 Session Aim:

To look at the story of the ten lepers being made well and see how important it is that we say thank you to Jesus.

Bible Verses to CHECK OUT!

Luke 17:11-19

VIDEO STORY:

Watch the YouTube video - 43 Jesus Heals Ten Lepers

YOU WILL NEED: Toilet rolls

Start this activity by playing the toilet paper mummy game where you completely wrap someone up in toilet paper - like a mummy. (You might decide that it is easier to just to bandage one arm instead.)

After you have played the game, say that today's story is about some men who had to wear lots of bandages all the time.

Read the story:

¹¹ Jesus was on his way to Jerusalem. Traveling from Galilee to Samaria, ¹² he came into a small town. Ten men met him there. These men did not come close to Jesus, because they all had a harmful skin disease. ¹³ But they called to him, "Jesus! Master! Please help us!"

¹⁴ When Jesus saw the men, he said, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." [a]

While the ten men were going, they were healed. ¹⁵ When one of them saw that he was healed, he went back to Jesus. He praised God in a loud voice. ¹⁶ Then he bowed down at Jesus' feet and thanked him. (This man was a Samaritan.) ¹⁷ Jesus asked, "Ten men were healed; where are the other nine? ¹⁸ Is this Samaritan the only one who came back to thank God?" ¹⁹ Then Jesus said to him, "Stand up and go on your way. You were healed because you believed."

> WHAT'S THE POINT? To tell the story.

ACTIVITY- GINGERBREAD MEN:

After baking, or having a pre-made gingerbread man, decorate your character. Use some white icing to create a few bandages too!

> WHAT'S THE POINT? To remind the children of the story and enjoy a treat.

PRAYER:

Ask if your children or anyone else they know needs Jesus to make them better. Pray for those that do with a very simple prayer: Jesus, please make better. Get everyone to join in with the "Amen". Say that it's really important that we say thank you to God for what he does.
